
The PreViser Comprehensive Risk Assessment gives the patient an overview of their oral health with scores that can change based on professional interventions and patient home care.

If the score predicts moderate or high risk for caries and/or periodontal disease then the enhanced benefits are activated immediately.




Important points to consider about the HOW® program benefits

- Enhanced benefits are **subject to standard policy provisions**, including but not limited to, **coinsurance percentages**, **copayments**, **and plan maximums**.
- If under the patient's plan, preventive benefits are deducted from the patient's **maximum benefit**, then the additional preventive benefits through the HOW® program are deducted from the **patient's maximum benefit** also.
- Sealants under the HOW® caries benefit are covered for unrestored primary molars, permanent molars and premolars; once per tooth every three years.
- Either one **nutritional counseling** or one **oral hygiene instruction**, or one **tobacco cessation counseling** is covered in a 12-month period.

What is PreViser?

PreViser® is an online dental risk assessment tool. PreViser's technology make them the leaders in predicting oral wellness through evidence-based risk scores that determine a patient's likelihood of getting oral diseases or that current disease may become worse in the future.

How often do we have to complete PreViser risk assessments for the HOW® program?

It is recommended as a best practice that risk assessments are completed on an annual basis.
